OUTLINE:

In this task you are required to show your understanding of an important medieval event by creating your own version of a pilgrimage presented as a travel brochure.

- Include descriptions and notes about what your travel company can offer a pilgrim.
- Include a list of all your sources of information in the form of a bibliography.

<p>Landmarks</p> <p>The Acropolis of Athens is an ancient citadel located on a rocky outcrop above the city of Athens, containing several of the most famous monuments of ancient Greek culture, including the Parthenon and the Propylaea.</p>  <p>Major Cities</p> <p>The most important of all Greek cities is Athens, the capital of the country, which contains more than one-third of the population. The second largest city is Thessaloniki on the Balkans and the third is Piraeus on the coast near Athens.</p> <p>Language 11 official languages, Greek with Turkish, others. Education is taught in approximately 100 different languages. Education is the predominant second language.</p> <p>Religion Greek Orthodox, with Muslim, Jewish, Catholic, Protestant.</p>	<p>What about Greece?</p> <p>Greece is located in the southern part of Europe and it is the southernmost country of the Balkan Peninsula. Greece is also located near the world's most active volcano.</p> <p>Greece was colonized as early as the 13th century BC and it was the first country to be colonized by the British Empire. In the 19th century, Greece was a country where 90% of the population was illiterate.</p> <p>Greece participated in the Balkan Wars in 1912-1913. The country of the war provided Greece with access to competing markets and also to the seas of the Balkan states. This led to a dramatic increase in economic growth, which gave a significant boost to economic growth.</p> <p>Greece is a democracy in reality, and has provided its citizens with 100% of the country's GDP.</p>	<p>Greece</p>   <p>Design: Whooler 15/11/11</p>
